Sgt. Jeffrey Farley P#1022, being first duly sworn, deposes and says:

THAT he/she is Affiant and a police officer with the Henderson Police Department, being so employed since 07/17/00, assigned to investigate the below listed crime(s) committed on or about 11/21/09 which investigation has developed Robert Frank as the perpetrator thereof.

That the above offense (s) occurred at 300 N. Green Valley Pkwy located in the City of Henderson County of Clark, State of Nevada. THAT Affiant learned the following facts in the course of the investigation of said crime, to-wit:

I conducted an investigation into the criminal complaint that Rosalyn Berman and Roger Cooper committed the act of Forgery, a felony violation of NRS 205.095, which is complete. The allegation against Mr. Cooper and Ms. Berman is not only unfounded, I have determined that the complaint filed by Robert Frank and Tim Stebbins was supported by statements and information they knew to be false. The manner in which they presented their statements and supporting documentation caused a criminal investigation to be conducted. Based on the following statements and observations, it was determined that Robert Frank and Tim Stebbins did deliberately report to the Henderson Police Department that a felony had been committed causing a criminal investigation to be conducted and that they knew the report to be false. As a result, they committed a misdemeanor violation of NRS 207.280, False Reporting of Crimes Unlawful.

On 11/21/09, Robert Frank and Tim Stebbins filed a report with the Henderson Police Department alleging the Rosalyn Berman and Roger Cooper committed the criminal act of Forgery. In his typed and signed statement, Mr. Frank wrote the following:

“This is to confirm that I was a Sun City Anthem Director/board member at the time of this alleged violation of NRS 205.095 concerning forgery. My personal background sheet is attached to assist the investigating officer in validating my qualifications to submit this type of suspected criminal report.”

“After dozens of hours of personal research, analysis and consultation with many local specialists in relevant areas of law enforcement, Mr. Stebbins and I are confident this case provides an example of forgery as defined in NRS 205.095.”

“I have first-hand knowledge that the accused board officers did knowingly sign what I believe can be proven
